# Screening, Brief Intervention and Referral to Treatment (SBIRT)

### A Public Health Approach

Research shows, at critical moments, just a brief screening and intervention can help someone reduce or stop risky substance use. In some cases, before misuse crosses into addiction.

## Substance use is one of America's Top Preventable Health Issues....

"SBIRT is a comprehensive, integrated, public health approach to the delivery of early intervention and treatment services for persons with substance



use disorders, as well as those who are at risk of developing these disorders." - SAMHSA 2010

Screening can be done via a variety of methods and only takes a few minutes

### Defining SBIRT

Screening refers to using a validated instrument to quickly assess the "risk level" of substance use and



el" SBIRT not only prevents substance use problems, it saves lives

identify individuals who might benefit from intervention.

**Brief Intervention (BI)** occurs when initial screening indicates a risk level as moderate to high; the focus is on increasing insight and awareness regarding substance use and motivation toward behavioral change.

**Brief Treatment (BT)** is similar to BI in emphasizing motivation to change and client empowerment. It may be used for those with moderate to high risk and be conducted over three or more sessions.

<u>Referral to Treatment (RT)</u> provides those at highest risk with access to specialty care.
